Bitter-Killpecker Creek Update and Actions <u>Drop Structure</u>

• Folks reported the drilling is completed and all seven bore sites are done.

Russ Hamilton, WWC, reported that the Geotech drilling was completed in January and went according to plan. AET will begin conducting their testing on the samples observed/collected and provide a report to WWC when they have the results.

#### USFW & WACD Cooperative Agreement Draw Down Request

Staff reported there is currently a funding pause, and it is in a review process. WACD and the landowner have been notified. According to Dave Kimble, FWS, they do have a backup plan if the funding is not made available and are still working out the details.
